

StretchTec Shoulder Relief Girth Marketing Points

1. Offset from center of the girth (where it lies in horse's girth groove) to the buckles allows the billets to attach farther back and prevent the saddle from interfering with the shoulders.
2. A horse's chest expands 1.5 cm on average in work, the center elastic allows for this expansion.
3. In traditional girths, peak pressure is at the horse's elbows (not sternum), and the cutaways at the elbow in the *StretchTec* Shoulder Relief Girth helps this.
4. The triangular center elastic shape allows a unique stretching property to keep even contact on the horse's body and contour better to the natural shape.
5. Liners/covers are removable and interchangeable for easier washing and multiple material options.
6. Intelligent and nearly indestructible looped billet keepers.
7. Patent pending design.
